Donation Categories Under Management

- Community Unrestricted Donations (15 endowments) - \$606,312.
- Field of Interest Donations (6 endowments) - \$193,662.
- Designated Fund Donations (13 endowments) - \$312,009.
- Scholarship Fund Donations (11 endowments) - \$398,131.
- Agency Fund Donations (11 endowments) - \$128,195.
- Donor Advised Fund Donations (5 endowments) - \$937,354.

\$2,575,666 total value of endowments (62 under management) \$90,148 investment income available was used to fund both Grants & Endowment distributions in 2021

\$3,173,434.91 total value of endowments and income available to fund both Grants & Endowment was \$142,804.57 in 2022.
